Just Energy Transition (JET) Funding Platform Webinar Series

Advancing the Just Energy Transition depends on good ideas becoming funded projects. Over 240 applications were submitted to the Just Energy Transition (JET) Funding Platform last year. The projects were JET-aligned and the ideas were transformative, but fewer than 15% were viable for funder matching.

For many organisations and initiatives, the challenge is not the quality of the idea, but the strength of the systems behind it.

The JET Funding Platform Webinar Series has been designed as a practical support service for all organisations working towards the social, economic, and climate goals of the Just Energy Transition.

Whether you are working to secure funders through the JET Funding Platform, other funding mechanisms, or by approaching individual funders directly, this webinar series will help you become investment ready.

The first webinar in the series focuses on institutional readiness: what funders and partners look for, where organisations most often face gaps, and what practical steps can strengthen a project or organisation before approaching funders.

We will unpack what institutional readiness means in practice, where organisations typically need to strengthen governance, financial management, compliance, and feasibility planning, and how these foundations can improve your chances of securing funding support.

Participants will also receive a governance self-assessment tool to help put the session into practice.

Webinar 1 gives an overview of the funding landscape, governance requirements, and institutional readiness.

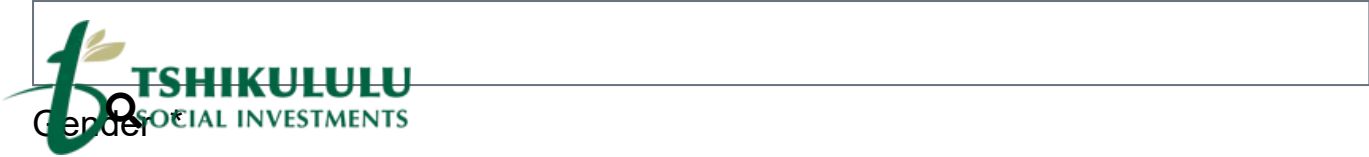
