

# Just Transition to a Decarbonised Economy for South Africa (JUST SA)

## Training Course on the Green Economy & Just Transition

### BACKGROUND

TIPS is an implementing partner of the **Just Transition to a Decarbonised Economy for South Africa (JUST SA)** project, an ambitious, multi-year initiative funded by the German government supporting the implementation of pathways towards an environmentally sustainable, climate-change resilient, low-carbon economy and just society in South Africa. Our political partner is the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment (DFFE).

As part of the project, we are offering practical, interactive, policy-focused training courses on the green economy and the Just Transition in **all nine provinces**.

### OBJECTIVE OF THE COURSE

The objective of the course is to deepen participants' understanding of the Green Economy and the Just Transition and how they relate to each other. The course will focus on:

1. How to develop and use policy to identify and unlock opportunities in the green economy; and
2. How to adapt policies and strategies to enable a Just Transition.

### TRAINING OUTCOMES

By the end of the course, participants should be able to:

1. Understand the risks and opportunities of transitioning to a green economy.
2. Enhance their understanding of the different policies for fostering the transition to climate-compatible industrial development.
3. Explain why a Just Transition is crucial in South Africa and why our transition is different from other countries.
4. Analyse the potential impacts of the transition on vulnerable groups in "at-risk" value chains and enhance their understanding of policies to foster a Just Transition within their province and/or municipality.

### FEES & DURATION

- The training course is **free of charge**.
- The course will be delivered over **2 days** in each of the provincial capitals to **20-30 mid- and senior-level provincial and local government officials** whose day-to-day responsibilities require a strong grasp of climate change, green economy and just transition issues.
- Participants are responsible for their travel and accommodation.
